This instrument, which comes into force on 23 October 2020, amends the Family Start and Early Start (Childcare Assistance) Programme established and approved on 12 September 2005 under the Social Security Act 1964 (and saved by Schedule 1 of the Social Security Act 2018). The amendment is to ensure that the assistance may continue to be paid during a child's temporary absence, due to COVID-19 requirements, from an early childhood education programme.

The instrument is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of the Legislation Act 2012.

The instrument is administered in the Ministry for Social Development.
