Explanatory note

This note is not part of the instrument, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This instrument, which comes into force on 1 April 2022, amends the directions in relation to Special Benefit and Advance Payments of Instalments of Benefit and a number of Ministerial welfare programmes under the Social Security Act 2018:

Clause 4 and Schedule 1:

- adjusts standard costs, in relation to the direction in relation to Special Benefit to reflect a 5.95% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2020 quarter to the December 2021 quarter (calculated using the CPI All Groups)
- adjusts the appropriate income thresholds in relation to Advance Payments of Instalments Benefit to reflect a 5.95% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2020 quarter to the December 2021 quarter (calculated using the CPI All Groups)

Clause 4 and Schedule 2:

- adjusts certain rates and limits in relation to Family Start and Early Start (Childcare Assistance) Programme, New Employment Transition Grant Programme, Recoverable Assistance Programme, Seasonal Work Assistance Programme, Special Needs Grant Programme and Training Incentive Allowance Programme to reflect a 5.95% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2020 quarter to the December 2021 quarter (calculated using the CPI All Groups)
- the Home Help Programme, to adjust the hourly rate to reflect a 6% increase in the adult minimum wage
- the Special Transfer Allowance Programme 2000 to adjust average regional rents to reflect movements in rentals
