Instrument

1 Title

This instrument is the Flexi-wage Employment Assistance (New Zealand Superannuation and Veteran's Pension) Amendment 2023.

2 Commencement

This instrument comes into force on 1 July 2023.

3 Principal programme


This instrument amends the Flexi-wage Employment Assistance Programme (established and approved on 9 February 2021).

4 Clause 6 amended (Eligibility for assistance)

- (1) In clause 6(2), revoke paragraph (d).

- (2) In clause 6(3)(b), after “is”, insert “no longer at risk of long-term benefit receipt because they are”.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the instrument, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This instrument, which comes into force on 1 July 2023, amends the Flexi-wage Employment Assistance Programme. The amendment removes the restriction that prevents assistance being granted to people who are eligible for New Zealand superannuation or veteran’s pension in their own right.
