

Family Violence Response Coordination Fund

The Government has allocated \$2.8 million to extend Family Violence Response Coordination contracts for one year.

Budget 2019

The initiative is part of a whole-of-government Joint Venture package of \$320 million over four years to prevent and respond to family violence and sexual violence.

- Family Violence Response Coordination (FVRC) contracts are being extended for one year.
- Based on current plans for 2019/20 contracting, about 37 existing MSD-funded organisations are expected to receive an extension to their contracts. This figure may change slightly as a result of the outcome of due diligence and contract negotiations.

The benefits of this funding include:

- The Family Violence Response Coordination Fund aims to prevent family violence, by enabling local community and government organisations to collectively develop an integrated and strategic approach to family violence in their communities.
