These papers provide a background to the social security agreement between New Zealand and the Republic of Korea and confirm Cabinet's approval to sign the agreement. New Zealand and Korea signed the social security agreement in October 2019. The agreement is scheduled to enter into force in 2021. The agreement will make it easier for people who travel between the two countries to access their pensions.

Some parts of this information release would not be appropriate to release and, if requested, would be withheld under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Where this is the case, the relevant sections of the Act that would apply have been identified. Where information has been withheld, no public interest has been identified that would outweigh the reasons for withholding it. This is the key to the redaction code used for this release:

- Section 9(2)(k) The contact details of Ministry of Social Development staff are withheld in order to reduce the possibility of staff being exposed to phishing and other scams.
- Out of scope Material unrelated to the information released.
