The Health Entitlement Cards Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 and the Social Security Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022

Portfolios Social Development and Employment / Health

On 1 September 2022, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that in June 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee agreed to amend the Health Entitlement Cards Regulations 1993 and the Social Security Regulations 2018 to add public transport authorities to those able to request or demand to see a Community Services Card and the combination SuperGold and Community Services Card as evidence that the cardholder is eligible for public transport concessions [SWC-22-MIN-0099].
- 2 **noted** that the Health Entitlement Cards Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 and the Social Security Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 attached in Appendix 1 will give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- authorised submission to the Executive Council of the:
 - 3.1 Health Entitlement Cards Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 [PCO 24826/4.0];
 - 3.2 Social Security Amendment Regulations (No2) 2022 [PCO 24827/4.0];
- 4 **noted** that the Health Entitlement Cards Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 and the Social Security Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022 come into force on 10 October 2022.
