These papers propose that the Cabinet Legislation Committee authorise the submission of the Privacy (Information Sharing Agreement between Inland Revenue and Ministry of Social Development) Amendment Order 2023 to Cabinet and the Executive Council.

This Order amends the existing Privacy (Information Sharing Agreement between Inland Revenue and Ministry of Social Development) Order 2017 to remove the required 10 working days' notice period for adverse actions when the Ministry of Social Development automatically charges child support as income as a result of an information share with Inland Revenue. It also updates this Order to reflect minor changes agreed between the agencies from September 2021.
