### Oral Item: Report of the Welfare Expert Advisory Group

### Portfolio Social Development

On 6 March 2019, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- 1 **noted** the briefing from the Chair of the Welfare Expert Advisory Group, outlining the recommendations of *Whakamana Tāngata Restoring Dignity to Social Security in New Zealand* (the report), including the proposed investment package and areas to prioritise;
- 2 **noted** that the report's recommendations focus on enhancing people's dignity, addressing the underlying issues that stop some from being able to move out of the welfare system, and increasing opportunities to engage with the workforce;
- 3 **noted** that the report will be released by early April 2019;
- 4 **noted** that there are challenges to the successful delivery of welfare reform beyond the cost, including operational capability and capacity, which mean that the response will likely need to be phased.
