• How many families currently living in Social Housing ki Tauranga are employed or on benefits – percentages

Since 14 April 2014, the Ministry of Social Development has been responsible for managing applications for social housing, calculating and administering incomerelated rent, and referring clients to approved social housing providers. The table below shows a breakdown of the main tenants of social housing in the Tauranga district by the type of benefit assistance, if any, that they receive. Please note that where low numbers may reveal an individual's identity the information has been suppressed to protect client privacy.

- Please note this table is the number of main tenants of social housing in the Tauranga District Territorial Local Authority and the type of benefit assistance, if any, that they receive as at 31 March 2016.
- Other Main Benefits includes Emergency Maintenance Allowance, Emergency Benefit and Jobseeker Support Student Hardship.

- Non-Beneficiary Assistance includes Orphan's Benefit, Unsupported Children's Benefit, Disability Allowance and Temporary Additional Support.
- No Benefit refers to clients not receiving benefit assistance from the Ministry of Social Development.
- S represents a suppressed cell to protect client privacy.
