On 17 September 2018, you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, the following information:

- The number of Disability Allowances granted to individuals under 18 years of age (so the individual under 18 years is the disabled person who qualifies for the Disability Allowance.
- Data on the crossover between the Child Disability Allowance and the Disability Allowance (e,g. how many disabled children/young people under 18 receive both).
- Data on the average, or median, amount paid for disabled children/young people under 18 in receipt of the Disability Allowance.
- This data is requested for the period 2013 to the most recent quarter.

Attached to this letter are six tables of data which address your request:

- The total number of Disability Allowances granted on behalf of children 17 or under for each quarter during the specified period.
- The total number of current Disability Allowances paid for children 17 or under, clients and partners as at the end of each quarter for the specified period showing the average and median rate of payment.
- The total number of Disability Allowances paid for a client or their partner whose age is 17 years or younger as at the end of each quarter during the specified period. Please note this differs from your previous request, where partners were not included in the data.
- The number of current Child Disability Allowances paid for children as at the end of each quarter during the specified period showing the average and median weekly rate.
- The number of children receiving both the Child Disability Allowance and Disability Allowance at the end of each quarter during the specified period.

For context, we are also providing the numbers of clients of all ages who are receiving the Disability Allowance in table six.

You will notice from the data in these tables that the number of Disability Allowances granted for persons under 18 years old has decreased between 2013 and 2018. The expansion of health services for children, including free General Practitioner visits for children under 13 since July 2015, is likely to be part of the reason for this decrease.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- · to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter and any attached documents available to the wider public shortly. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter and attachments on the Ministry of Social Development's website. Your personal details will be deleted and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
