On 2 November 2018, you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, details regarding Transitional Housing Providers and emergency housing in Porirua the during last 24 months.

As you will be aware, the Ministry of Social Development and the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development work to ensure people have their immediate housing needs met. Temporary accommodation is primarily provided in the form of Transitional Housing and Emergency Housing Special Needs Grants (EH SNGs).

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Development works with a range of non-governmental organisations to provide Transitional Housing services. The Ministry contracts these providers to ensure access to appropriate short term accommodation as a stepping stone to long-term, sustainable housing. The part of your request which relates to Transitional Housing has been transferred to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development.

When no suitable Transitional Housing is available, the Ministry of Social Development can help meet the cost of short-term accommodation with an EH SNG. The EH SNG was introduced on 1 July 2016 in order to fund temporary accommodation at places such as hostels and motels to meet people's immediate housing needs. In most cases an EHSNG does not need to be paid back.

Please find attached a table providing the number of EH SNGs from the December 2016 quarter to the September quarter 2018. Please note that the location of EH SNGs is recorded according to the Work and Income site at which it was issued. As such, an EH SNG may be issued for a client seeking accommodation in a different area. Following is a list of motels in Porirua that have received an Emergency Housing Special Needs Grant payment on behalf of a client.
