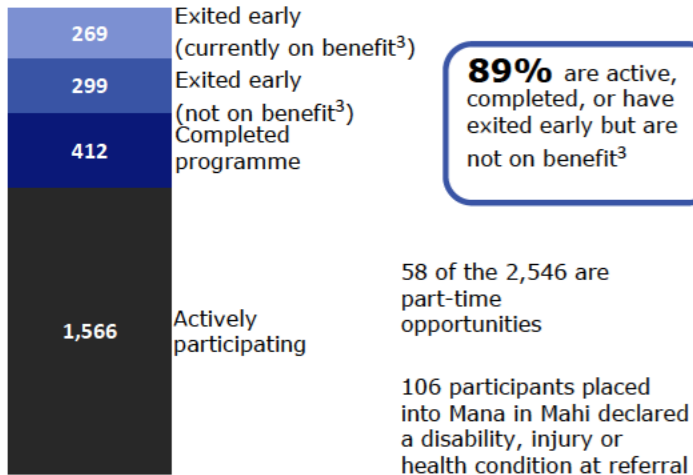


## 1. Overview

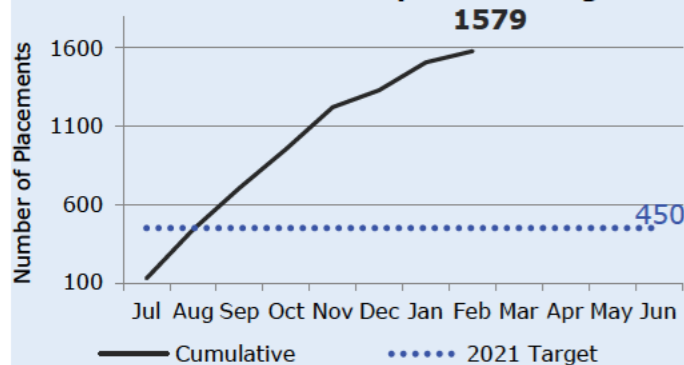

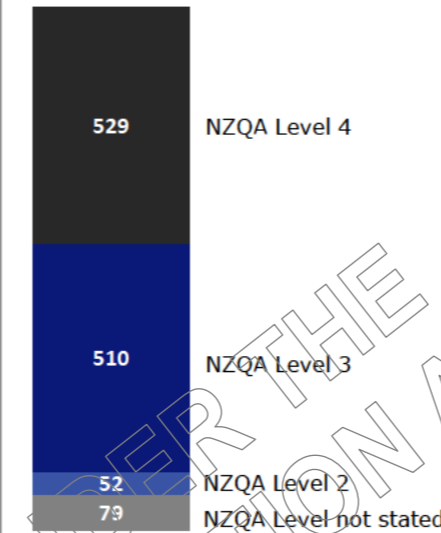
**72%** of those on benefit for 2+ years at referral are active, completed, or exited early (not on benefit<sup>3</sup>)

## 3. Training Pathways

**1,170** of the 1566 active participants have Training Pathways



Note, the 1566 active participants includes those who have newly started, which is why they don't all have Training Pathways. Participants are not required to enter a Training Pathway until they reach 91 days.

### 91 day Training Pathway Measure

**1,198** of the 1566 active participants have been in the programme 91 days or longer

**936** of the 1198 have a training pathway in place

**78%** have Training Pathways of those active in the programme for 91 days

## 4. Employers

**1,480** Contracted employers  
**366** Small (1-19)  
**54** Medium (20-49)  
**72** Large (50+)

Note, employer size is based on number of employees, as reported by employers. 988 do not have a reported size, mostly due to this feature not yet being available in CMS.

## 5. Points of Interest

There has been a slight increase since January in the proportion of participants receiving the Sole Parent Support benefit at the time of referral.

Since January, an additional 117 participants who were previously receiving a Job Seekers benefit have been placed into a Mana in Mahi opportunity.

### Training Pathways

Of the 1170 participants on a Training Pathway, 89% of those are working towards a qualification at NZQA level 3 or higher.
