



5. Points of Interest

There has been a slight increase since January in the proportion of participants receiving the Sole Parent Support benefit at the time of referral.

Since January, an additional 117 participants who were previously receiving a Job Seekers benefit have been placed into a Mana in Mahi opportunity.

Training Pathways

Of the 1170 participants on a Training Pathway, 89% of those are working towards a qualification at NZQA level 3 or higher.
