On 1 April 2022, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• The figure of the amount granted in Emergency Housing Special Needs Grants paid to Ritz Enterprises Limited of \$1,067,095.00 for the period 1 July 2019 to 30 November 2021 be broken down into quarters. Quarters ending in December, March, June and September for each year in my request from 1 July 2019 to 30 November 2021.

Please find below **Table One** which contains the amount granted in Emergency Housing Special Needs Grants to Ritz Enterprises Limited during the period 1 July 2019 to 31 March 2022, organised by Quarter.

Notes for Table One:

- The number of grants is not the number of clients.
- A client may have more than one grant during the reported period.
- This is the amount granted.
- The total amount granted may not be the same as the amount spent.
- To protect confidentiality, the Ministry uses processes to make it difficult to identify an individual person or entity from published data.
- These data tables have had random rounding to base three applied to all cell counts in the table.
- A value of one or two may be rounded to zero or three.
- The impact of applying random rounding is that columns and rows may not add exactly to the given column or row totals.
- The published counts will never differ by more than two counts.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry's website.
