Tēnā koe

On 23 April 2023, you emailed the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

- *I am making an enquiry to obtain information about a substantial grant of approximately \$30,000 made for a project in the Birkdale Beach Haven area over the covid period for community development administered by the Birkdale Beach Haven Community Project known locally as the Birkdale and Beach Haven Houses.*
- *I would like to know what this money was to be used for within the Birkdale Beach Haven community.*

Your request was transferred to the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) on 5 May 2023 as the information to which your request relates is believed to be more closely connected with the functions of the Ministry.

While the Ministry provides funding to the Birkdale Beach Haven Community Project, no single payment of approximately \$30,000 has been made. Therefore, I am refusing your request under section 18(g) of the Act as the information you had requested is not held by the Ministry and I have no grounds to believe that the information is either held by or closely connected to the functions of another department, Minister of the Crown or organisation.

In **Appendix One** below, I have provided you with a table that shows funding made to this provider by the Ministry from 1 January 2020 to 30 June 2023.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter and any attached documents available to the wider public. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry's website. Your personal details will be deleted, and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
