
Please refer to Table One in the **Appendix** below for information on YP/YPP intake referrals, broken down by month, referral location and total figures.

Notes:

- This includes YP/YPP intakes (Young Payment, Young Parent Payment, Young Partner, and Young Parent Partner).
- This excludes people referred to NEET.
- This includes only where the Event types are Referral Created or Enrolled.
- This is based on client's address in Hutt Valley district (location indicator in ART - tool used and managed by providers), which includes Lower Hutt, Wainuiomata, Naenae, and Upper Hutt client's districts recorded in Activity Reporting Tool (ART).
- This is a count of distinct clients who have been referred or enrolled to a Youth Service Provider.
- This includes only Vibe Hutt Valley Youth Health Trust and W&I Wellington Inhouse Service Providers.
- To protect confidentiality, the Ministry of Social Development uses processes to make it difficult to identify an individual person or entity from published data.
- These data tables have had random rounding to base three applied to all cell counts in the table.
- Random rounding does not round down to zero, a value of one or two will be rounded to three.
- The impact of applying random rounding is that columns and rows may not add exactly to the given column or row totals.
- The published counts will never differ by more than two counts.
