Official Information Act request

On 26 April 2024, you advised the Ministry of Social Development that you were requesting a copy of all disposal authorities held by the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry), both expired and current.

Firstly, I would like to apologise for the delay in responding to your request for official information.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on your request set out below.

The Ministry contacted you on 3 July 2024 and on 8 July 2024 in order to seek a refinement on your request. As the Ministry has not heard from you to date, I have interpreted your request to be for disposal authorities covering records of individuals in the state care system.

I have found two documents in scope of your request which are publicly available on Archives NZ's website. Please visit the below links for these documents:

If you would like to read disposal authorities on any other type of records, you can find them on Archive NZ's website. I recommend searching with the key words 'disposal authority'.

Please note, Ministry policy documents indicate that authority to dispose of records was also in effect prior to this time, but documentation of the relevant authorities is not readily available and would require substantial manual collation to potentially identify and locate. As such, the Ministry has not undertaken a search for these documents. If you would like these documents, please contact the Ministry.

I will be publishing this decision letter, with your personal details deleted, on the Ministry's website in due course.
