Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 21 May 2024, requesting additional information on delegated authority under section 317 of the Social Security Act 2018.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on each part of your request set out separately below.

- *Has the Chief Executive has exercised the authority granted by the Minister to sub-delegate her correction power?*

Yes, the Chief Executive has exercised her authority to sub-delegate this correction power.

- *To whom and what term?*


The Chief Executive has subdelegated her authority to the Deputy Chief Executive Service Delivery only and without an end date. The sub-delegation is open ended, i.e., it has no term or end date. However, the Chief Executive can revoke the sub-delegation at any time.
