Official Information Act Request

The Department of Corrections has transferred your request for information about the Steps to Freedom grant to the Ministry of Social Development. I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Steps to Freedom is a non-recoverable re-establishment grant that is part of the Special Needs Grant welfare programme. Like other re-establishment grants, entitlement is based on an applicants identified needs to re-establish themselves in the community.

A form of the Steps to Freedom grant has existed since 1983. When the grant was originally introduced it was available at a maximum of twice the single youth rate of the unemployment benefit at that time.

The grant has remained at \$350 since 1991, as the grant is not indexed to inflation, or to average wage growth as main benefits are.
